Each year, we provide assistance to many fellow creations who find themselves in unexpected hardship. With your help, we can step in during these critical moments, offering not just financial relief, but hope and stability when and where it is needed most.

One of the families we recently assisted is a hard-working family that has been struggling to escape the cycle of homelessness for over a year. The father works full time to support the household, while the mother serves as a full-time caregiver to their special needs daughter. After losing their previous rental due to circumstances beyond their control, they have been unable to save enough to secure new housing. Because of their daughter's needs, including both physical and verbal outbursts, they require a single-family home rather than an apartment setting. They also have a beloved emotional support dog that helps comfort the daughter, and the whole family, during difficult episodes.

Thanks to the Family Foundation 2026 \$40,000 Matching Grant, we have been able to provide critical support to help this family move forward. The father's vehicle has been repaired, ensuring he can reliably get to work. We will soon assist with the first month's rent and security deposit once a suitable home is found, allowing the family to finally leave the motel they have been living in for months. In the meantime, gas and grocery gift cards have helped ease the strain on their limited budget.

Another family we assisted this week was left devastated after a fire destroyed their home and all their belongings. While they await payment from their insurance provider, we were able to step in and help meet their immediate needs, including shelter, food, and other daily essentials.

We also helped a homeless senior woman secure safe housing by covering her rent and security deposit. Living in a shelter, or a car, is difficult at any age, but for elderly and disabled individuals, it can be especially overwhelming. For this woman, having a place to call her own again brought tears of relief. With the addition of comfortable shoes and basic household necessities, she is now safe, settled, and deeply grateful, thanks to the Family Foundation 2026 \$40,000 Matching Grant.

Next week we will share with you where every dollar of the Family Foundation 2026 \$40,000 Matching Grant was spent. One hundred percent of this grant, and all your donations, goes directly to providing poverty relief.
